For a prophecy to have any value at all it should state clearly and unambiguously what's going to happen to whom, where, and when and not in symbolic language that needs to be decoded. It should be something that wouldn't have happened eventually anyway, and if it does, it should definitely have a time limit. Without that, you can't claim success because anything that can happen, will happen if given enough time. Such are the many failed biblical prophecies.

As the author states in the preface, 'It all began before the foundations of the world were put in place. Satan decided in his heart that he was going to take over God's kingdom. When God created mankind and placed Adam and Eve in a garden called Eden with the purpose of taking care of planet Earth, Satan realized that mankind would be his pathway to achieving his goal. He would seduce mankind with deceit...' So, if you are starting with the premise that a god created the heavens and the earth in six days, and snakes and donkeys can speak, then this book will be right up your alley.

Prophecies particularly appeal to the paranoid and are especially popular with conspiracy theorists seeking patterns that are not apparent to any rational person. Believers determine their interpretations by arbitrarily shifting from literal to metaphorical and back again with no rhyme or reason or discernable distinctions. Reading between the lines, and then ignoring the lines such that one verse is taken to refer to a whole other topic than the rest of the chapter just because it sounds similar to something else.

End-time prophecies and predictions are a dime a dozen with each one claiming to be the ultimate truth. Interestingly, it was William Cowper, the English poet, who wrote that "those most eager to find truth are often those most likely to deny it, even when confronted by its obvious presence."

Clearly intended for and recommended to fundamentalist Christians. 2 ½ stars from me for the effort that went into writing the book. However, its content has been scholarly debunked as nothing more than forged documents.
