This thought-provoking treatise by author Adrian Benard may cause even devout followers of Christian religion to re-think some of its basic premises. He has clearly done diligent research on how and why the Holy Bible was created. One compelling question he poses initially is why there are so many versions of the Bible – why do religious writers feel compelled to change/interpret this book generation and after generation? Some of the weaknesses embedded in biblical lore brought to light by Benard include: the Bible was written thousands of years ago, treating earth's creation as having just, suddenly, come about, though science shows that the earth is millions of years old; the word for God in the Bible is Elohim, which is plural; the Bible states that men were created in God's image, but women were created in the image of men. These and other issues can provide lively fodder for group discussion and individual contemplation.
